The Florida Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP) in cooperation with the Center for Urban Transportation Research (CUTR) and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be presenting the **Non-Emergency Stretcher Training (N.E.S.T.) Workshop**, September 14-15, 2010 in Marianna, Florida.

COURSE OBJECTIVE

The safe handling and transporting of clients presents transit operators with a broad spectrum of challenges. For this reason, we are presenting a course to discuss the meaning of the terms *non-emergency* and *emergency conditions*; raise awareness as how professionalism relates to roles of the non-emergency transport; review all aspects of the "request for transport;" examine the various equipment types; practice and be tested in the patient assessment procedure and collection of vital information; discuss sensitivity issues; and review proper vehicle control procedures and operation in defensive driving. Additional training in first responder curriculum will be discussed as well.

Upon completion, each attendee will receive a course manual and associated training aids. Additionally, participants will receive a certificate of training for completion of the two-day course.
