## COURSE OBJECTIVE

The National Transit Institute Workplace Safety and Security program area is pleased to announce a new course, **Advanced Mobility Device Securement**. The goal of this course is to assist transit operators in the best practices and principles of securing individuals and their manual and powered mobility devices.

Participants who complete the Advanced Mobility Device Securement course will be able to:

- Demonstrate techniques to safely and effectively secure manual and powered mobility devices on a vehicle
- Practice the proper placement and securement of seat belts on individuals using manual and powered mobility devices
- Utilize proper body mechanics to minimize injuries while securing devices and their passengers

To accomplish these objectives, the course integrates lecture, visual aids, participant discussion and interaction, individual exercises, and small-group exercises. A copy of the Participant Workbook and other course handouts will be provided to each participant.

Upon completion, each participant will receive a certificate of completion.
